Focus passage – Luke 9:23 *“If any man would come after Me, let him deny himself, and take his cross daily, and follow me.”*

1) What do you think your main purpose in life is?

2) According to the author of “The Four Priorities,” what is the purpose of life?

3) What is the first step for living the Christian Life?

4) What is the second step for living the Christian Life?

“Pray without ceasing.” 1 Thessalonians 5:17

5) What is the third step for living the Christian Life?

“If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.” [John 8:31-32]

6) What is the fourth step for living the Christian Life?

Commitment: I commit to pursuing God so He can conform me into the image of Jesus Christ.

Living the Christian Life – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “Living the Christian Life”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the five remaining questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: To be conformed into the image of Jesus Christ.
 - b. Question #3 answer: Denying ourselves and developing a deep relationship with God.
 - c. Question #4 answer: To have an active and regular prayer life.
 - d. Question #5 answer: Read God’s word regularly.
 - e. Question #6 answer: Be disciplined with our minds, bodies, and the practice of attending a regular Christian worship service.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to help each other with the steps for living the Christian life.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly Father, forgive us for putting other things and people before loving You. Please give us a deep desire to be like Your Son Jesus. In His name we pray. Amen.
