Priority #1: A personal progressive commitment to Jesus Christ
Program: #CA 23 (TFP1) – The Holy Spirit

Focus passage – Galatians 5:22-23 *“The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.”*

1) Do you ever get discouraged trying to live as a Christian?

2) What is the first quality of the Holy Spirit that was discussed?

3) What is the second quality of the Holy Spirit that was discussed?

“And when you believed in Christ, He identified you as His own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom He promised long ago.” Ephesians 1:13

4) What is the third quality of the Holy Spirit that was discussed?

“The Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things, and will remind you of everything I have said to you.” John 14:26

5) What is the fourth quality of the Holy Spirit that was discussed?

6) What is the fifth quality of the Holy Spirit that was discussed?

Commitment: I commit to allowing God’s Holy Spirit to work in my life.

The Holy Spirit – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1. Remind the men that what is shared in the group is confidential.
5. Listen to the program: “The Holy Spirit”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the five remaining questions with the men in the group. Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: The Holy Spirit is a person.
 - b. Question #3 answer: The Holy Spirit is in people who have accepted Jesus Christ as their only Savior. (Ephesians 1:13)
 - c. Question #4 answer: The Holy Spirit opens our minds so we can understand God’s word.
 - d. Question #5 answer: The Holy Spirit reminds us of what we’ve read and studied in God’s word.
 - e. Question #6 answer: The Holy Spirit prays for us. (Romans 8:26-27).
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to help each other to be more aware of the Holy Spirit working in their lives.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for giving us the Holy Spirit. Help us to be open to His influence in our lives.. In Jesus name we pray. Amen.
