## Our Mental Assets – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “Our Mental Assets”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the five remaining questions with the men in the group.  
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
  - a. Question #2 answer: Christian minds think supernaturally.
  - b. Question #3 answer: Christians understand what evil is – based on the Bible.
  - c. Question #4 answer: Christian men focus on the Truth.
  - d. Question #5 answer: A Christian mind accepts God’s authority.
  - e. Question #6 answer: A Christian mind has concern about people.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to challenging each other develop a Christian mind.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly father, please help us to love you with all our heart, soul, strength, and mind. In Jesus name, Amen.
