## The Christian Calling – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “The Christian Calling”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the four remaining questions with the men in the group.  
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
  - a. Question #2 answer:
    - 1) Follow God and proclaim Him to others.
    - 2) Use our gifts, talents, skills, and passions to God’s glory.
  - b. Question #3 answer: Identify what we are passionate about.
  - c. Question #4 answer: Identify where are gifting (skills) is.
  - d. Question #5 answer: Identify our role preference.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to help each other to identify God’s calling on their life.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly Father, please help us to identify how you want us to serve you. In Jesus name, Amen.
