Program #CA 38 (TFP4) – The Kingdom Mentality

Focus passage – Colossians 1:13-14, *“For he [God] has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins”*

The Kingdom Mentality – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “The Kingdom Mentality”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the six remaining questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: 1) God’s kingdom. 2) Satan’s kingdom.
 - b. Question #3 answer: They stand on the truth of the Bible. (2 Tim 3:16.)
 - c. Question #4 answer: They share the truths of the Bible.
 - d. Question #5 answer: They care about people God cares about. (Luke 10:30-36)
 - e. Question #6 answer: They take action when faced with injustice.
 - f. Question #7 answer: They have an eternal perspective. (1 John 5:11-13)
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to help each other to develop the qualities for a kingdom mentality.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, please help us to live with a kingdom mentality in our public life, our private life, and when we’re alone. In Jesus name, Amen.
