Program #CA 39 (TFP4) – Methods of Evangelism

Focus passage – 1 Peter 3:15, *“if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it”*

Methods of Evangelism – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “Methods of Evangelism”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the six remaining questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: Having sensitivity to the Lord’s leading.
 - b. Question #3 answer: Be ready to share your testimony. (1 Peter 3:15.)
 - c. Question #4 answer: Take the initiative to engage the person. (Acts 8:29-30)
 - d. Question #5 answer: Be tactful and respectful.
 - e. Question #6 answer: Be precise with your response.
 - f. Question #7 answer: Be decisive. (Acts 8:26 - 40)
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask anyone who has not accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord, if they would like to do so. (Ask the group, not an individual—unless prompted by God to do so.)
10. Ask the men to help each other to be more intentional in sharing their testimony.
11. Confirm the time for the next meeting
12. Take prayer requests.
13. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for offering us the gift of salvation. Please empower us to share this gift with others. In Jesus name, Amen.
