## Our Work – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: “Our Work”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the five remaining questions with the men in the group.  
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
  - a. Question #2 answer: Find ways to serve people with needs.
  - b. Question #3 answer: All work is honorable work.
  - c. Question #4 answer: God calls us to our vocation.
  - d. Question #5 answer: We should honor God in our work.
  - e. Question #6 answer: We need a godly balance between work and our personal lives.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to helping each other have a godly attitude toward work.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, please help us to be thankful for our jobs and use them to glorify you. In Jesus name, Amen.
